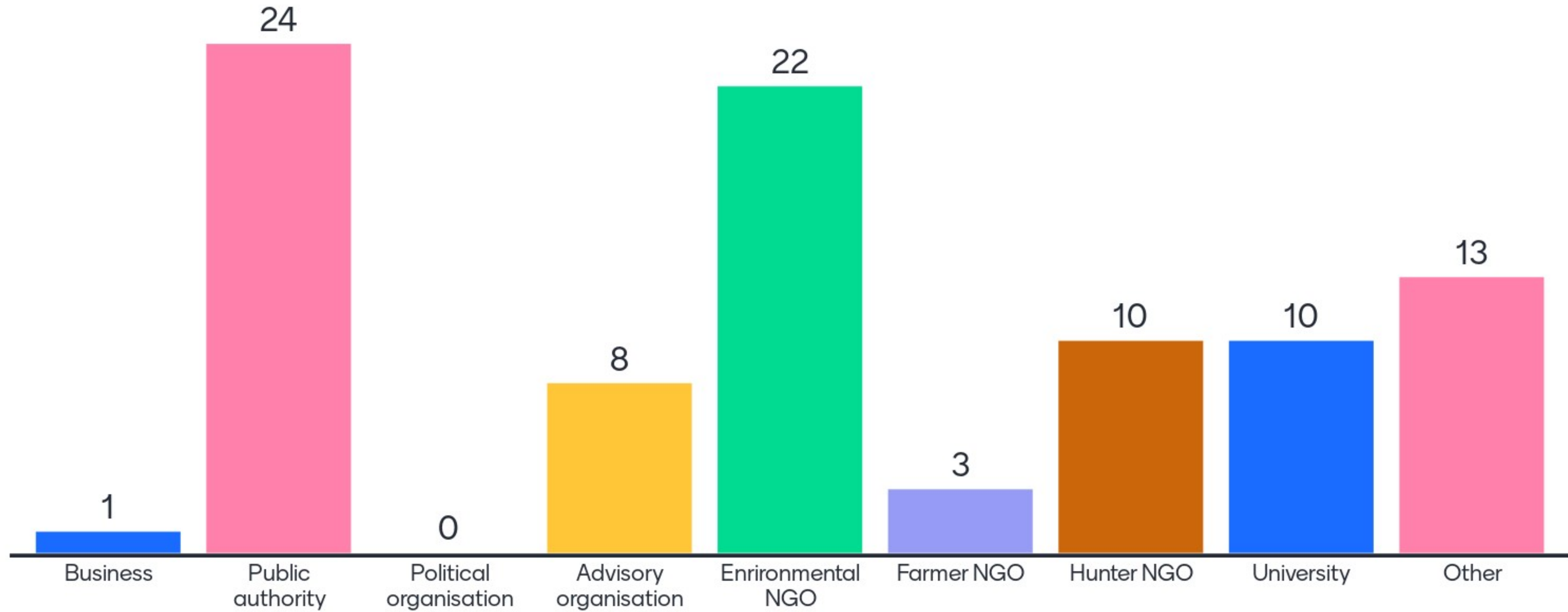

The need to take measures on all levels - from field to policy, incl the broader farming community and advisory services

Integrate measures

We need more diversity in agricultural landscapes over large surfaces

We need more wildlife friendly habitat in the agricultural areas across the EU and more high quality advice to farmers

More needs to be done to encourage bio-diversity and at a larger scale

Make advisory project in Norway

We need to involve as many different stakeholder groups as possible, to restore farmland biodiversity

More and better farm advise - and more results-based approaches

More ambition out of cap, member states need to be held to account.

Improving habitat quality on farmlands is the key for meeting biodiversity targets. Working on habitats and implementing environmental schemes must be more rewarding for farmers. All stakeholders included

Cooperation - creates relationships and builds trust

We need to find a new approach to change the state of mind of farmers and other stakeholders. That could be preventing soil degradation, especially important as we have also climate change crisis

1. Farmers are willing to do something but are put off by lack of flexibility
2. Even 6 six years of research and intensive work on the ground is not sufficient to have clear results. need to scale up

That there has to be more communication on the local scale.

Farmers need to get more responsibility and guidance to successfully contribute to biodiversity goals

Collaborate and connectify with farmers, flexibility of implementing files.

The main part of the needed work will rest on the member states eco regimes that will/are defined locally. which in turn will be heavily influenced by local stakeholders, like farmers organizations.
